Last year many of you answered a Parish Council questionnaire about the future of Medbourne and whether you wanted a Neighbourhood Plan. Most people said 'yes'. To make this Neighbourhood Plan happen we need to find out more about the things you think are important.

The Neighbourhood Plan isn't just about housing, it is about the whole village and what you want it to be like in the future.

We want you to tell us -

- What is important to you about Medbourne?
- What views and green spaces do we want to keep?
- Are there other services that we need?
- Do we need to do more to encourage small local businesses?
- What kind of houses do we need? What should they look like?

This is your chance to have a say in what Medbourne will be like in the future. The Harborough District Council options being considered may require 35-40 houses to be built in Medbourne over the next 15 years. Come and have your say on what type of houses these are and where they are built.

The Medbourne Neighbourhood Plan will be a statutory part of planning so it is vital that it reflects the wishes of the village community.
